<p>Position Purpose This position reports to the Shift Supervisor and is responsible for the operation of the milling train and powerhouse stations. <i>Duties of this position include, but are not limited to:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maintaining appropriate crushing rate. • Applying specified maceration rates. • Maintaining factory low pressure steam and electricity supply. • Exporting the maximum amount of electricity when practicable. • Utilising equipment efficiently and in a safe manner. • Using the minimum amount of diesel generated electricity and imported electricity in achieving the above outcomes. • Perform duties utilising other skills during times that their operating skills are not required on their station. This work may be on their station, or elsewhere in the factory. • Oversee the duties of the Assistant Platform Operator with a view to ensuring that they are carried out in an efficient and safe manner. • Provide instruction, information and training to the Assistant Platform Operator as required.
