<p>Position Purpose</p> <p>This position reports to the Shift Supervisor and is required to provide services to support production at the factory site by operating process plants and machinery such as non-slew crane, forklift, end-loader, bobcat, overhead crane and truck.</p> <p><i>Duties of this position include, but are not limited to:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Safely carry out operations, maintenance and inspections on plants and machinery within scope of responsibility whilst following procedures, using appropriate PPE, meeting quality control and making recommendations for improvements. • Perform basic plants and machinery troubleshooting and report defects as required. • Clean various areas within the factory including but not limited to such areas as cane receivable station, cane belt, shredder and general housekeeping as required. • Assist the Shift Supervisor as required during mill breakdowns and scheduled maintenance.

<p>Physical Requirements</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ability to perform work while wearing appropriate PPE (e.g. long clothing, hearing and eye protection, etc.) • Ability to work in a hot, moist environment. • Ability to perform work in a standing position for long periods in a vibrating environment. • Ability to walk and climb stairs regularly as well as the ability to bend and work with back hunched for short periods. • Ability to lift and carry loads in accordance with the Manual Tasks Advisory Standard 2000. • Hearing – ability to hear and differentiate radio and phone communications and alarms in a noisy environment. • Eyesight – ability to satisfy the vision requirements for a Qld Driver's Licence.
