

MILLS & CARRIER ATTENDANT

Sugar Industry Classification:	Up to Level 3 (depending on experience and training)
<p>Position Purpose:</p> <p>This position reports to the Shift Supervisor and is to carry out machinery checks and cleaning in the cane receivals, cane preparation, Milling and boilers areas.</p> <p><i>Duties of this position include, but are not limited to:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Uncoupling and re-coupling cane bins at tip • Clean various areas within the factory including but not limited to such areas as cane belt and shredder, milling train floors, walkways and mill cheeks, intermediate carrier drive platforms and general housekeeping as required • Undertake pinning and unpinning of bins as per shared role • Assist with Mill cleaning on Shutdown followed by Cleaning of Cane Receivals Area • Dumping boiler grates including No 6 and No 7. 	
<p>Length of Seasonal Work</p> <p>Historically, the crushing season commences start of June through to November/ December each year. The length of the season is heavily dependent on crop size, weather conditions and factory reliability.</p>	
<p>Fitness for Duty</p> <p>Prior to being offered employment, you will be required to undergo fitness for duty screening to test for the presence of alcohol and/or illicit substances. The Company will cover expenses related to this testing.</p>	
<p>Hours of Work</p> <p>Mulgrave Mill operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week during the crushing season. Seasonal positions for the crushing season involve shift work depending on what role is being undertaken. It is a requirement that all candidates are able to work shift work even if initially you are not successful in obtaining a shift role. The crushing shift roster works on an 8hr shift following a continuous crushing pattern. In addition to ordinary hours, there is an expectation for employees to be available to work reasonable amounts of overtime although overtime is not guaranteed by the Company.</p>

Physical Requirements:

- Ability to be able to operate machinery or vehicles.
- Ability to perform shiftwork and weekend work.
- Ability to perform work while wearing appropriate PPE e.g. long clothing, hearing and eye protection.
- Ability to work in a hot, moist environment.
- Ability to perform work in a standing position for long periods in a vibrating environment.
- Ability to walk and climb stairs regularly as well as the ability to bend and work with back hunched for short periods.
- Ability to lift and carry loads in accordance with the Manual Tasks Advisory Standard 2000.
- Hearing – ability to hear and differentiate radio and phone communications and alarms in a noisy environment.
- Eyesight – ability to satisfy the vision requirements for a Qld Driver's Licence.


